**APPROXIMATE QUILT SIZE**

50" x 70"

**NUMBER OF BLOCKS AND FINISHED SIZE**

18 Double Irish Chain Blocks - 10" x 10"

17 Alternating Blocks - 10" x 10"

**FABRIC REQUIREMENTS**

Red ... 1 1/2 yards

Blue #1 ... 1 1/2 yards (squares and binding)

Blue #2 ... 7/8 yard (stars)

Cream ... 2 1/8 yards

Backing ... 3 1/2 yards

Batting ... Twin Size

**CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS**

**Red**

... 19 strips 2 1/2" x WOF (width of fabric)

**Blue #1**

... 11 strips 2 1/2" x WOF

**Blue #2**

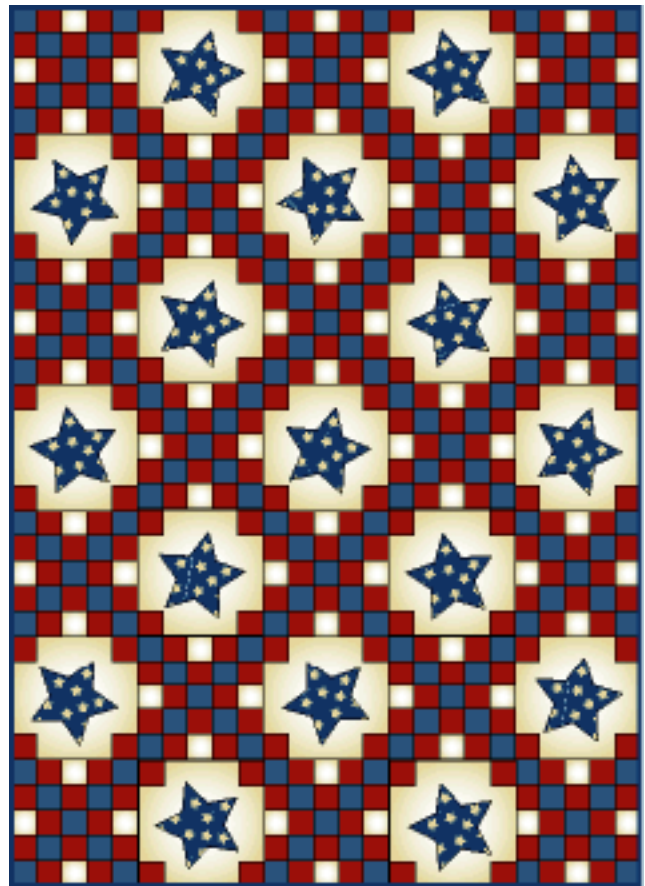
... 17 stars (Template A)

**Cream**

... 5 strips 2 1/2" x WOF

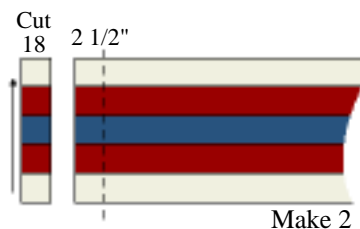
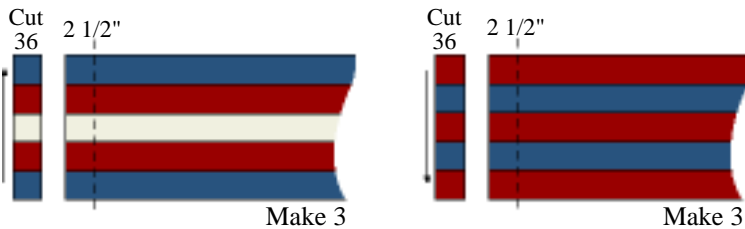
... 3 strips 6 1/2" x WOF

... 17 rectangles 6 1/2" x 10 1/2"

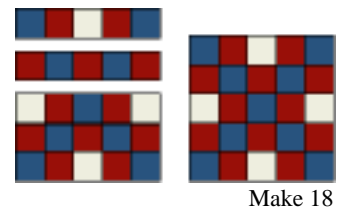


**PIECING THE BLOCKS**

**1.** Referring to **Diagram I-A**, sew red, cream, and blue #1 2 1/2" x WOF strips together. Make quantities of each color combination shown. Press in direction of arrow. Cut 2 1/2" wide segments in quantities shown. Arrange and stitch segments together to complete Double Irish Chain Block (see **Diagram I-B**). Make 18.

2. Referring to **Diagram II-A**, sew red 2 1/2" x WOF strips to sides of cream 6 1/2" x WOF strip. Make 3. Press in direction of arrow. Cut into 34 segments 2 1/2" wide. Stitch segments to sides of 6 1/2" x 10 1/2" rectangle to complete Alternate Block (see **Diagram II-B**.) Make 17.

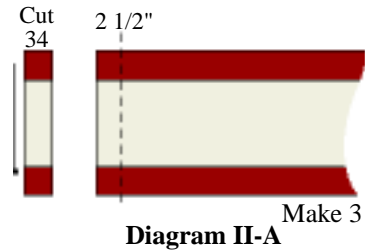
**QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY**

3. Alternating Double Irish Chain and Alternate Blocks, sew 7 rows of 5 blocks each. Sew rows together (see **Assembly Diagram**).

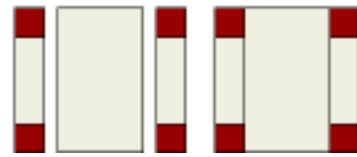
4. \*Using appliqué method of your choice, center stars in alternating blocks (see **Assembly Diagram**) and appliqué in place.

**QUILTING AND FINISHING**

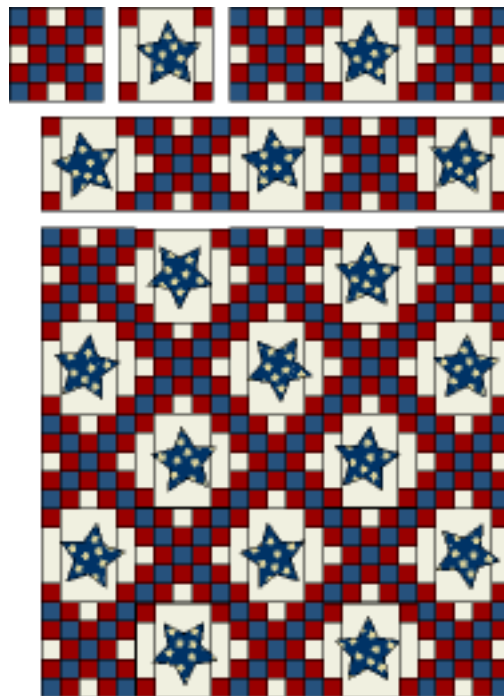
5. Layer and baste quilt top for quilting method of your choice. Quilt as desired. Bind quilt with blue #1 fabric.

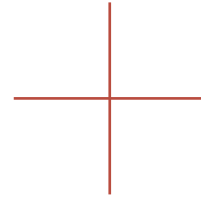

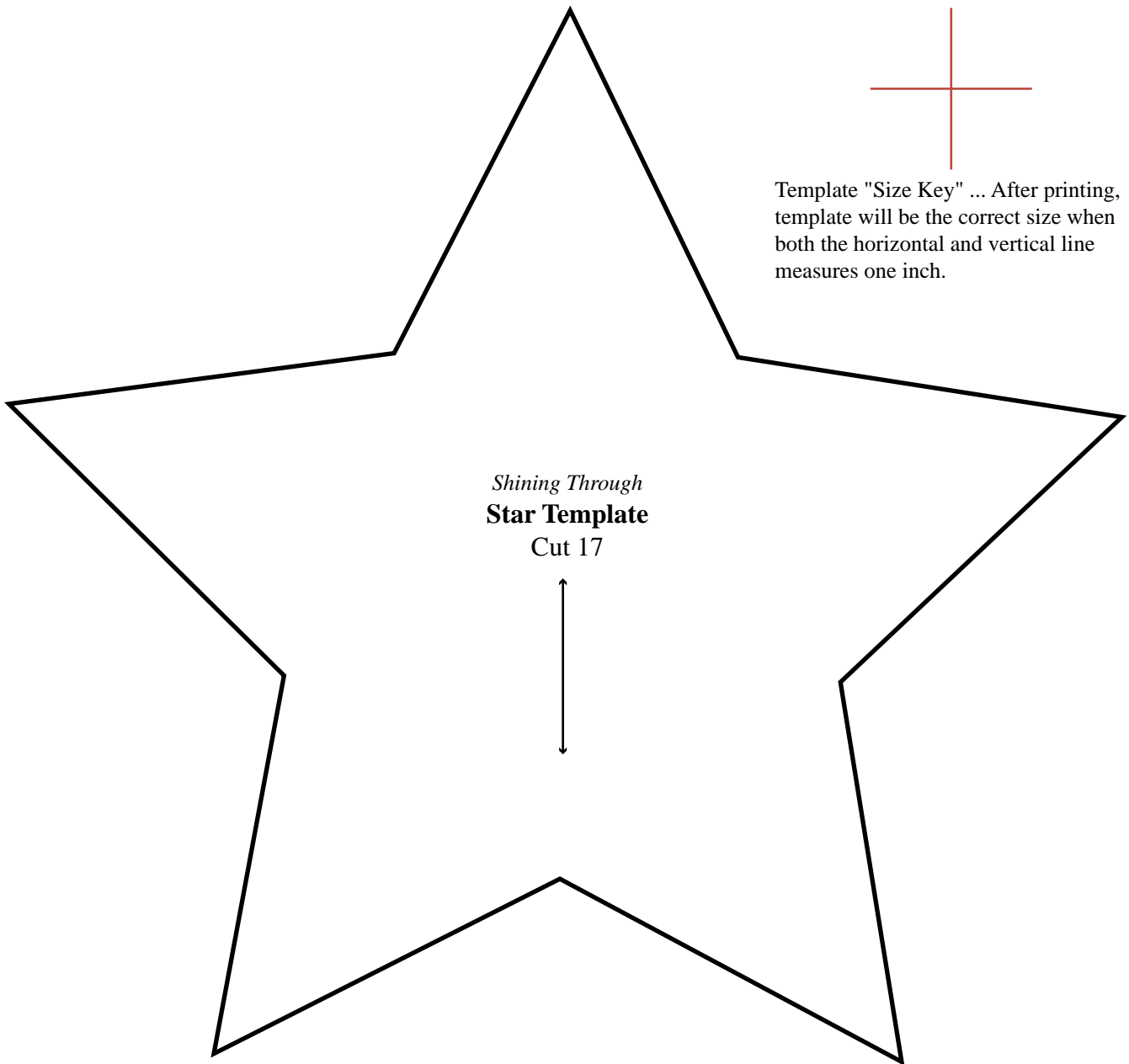
